The technology was demoed during this year's 5G Days at Nokia's Paris-Saclay campus. In Q1 of 2020, a more extensive pilot will be operated across the campus, the first in several use cases that will be implemented by the LMAD consortium of partners (including Bestmile, GIM Robotics, BookIT, PICOM, Forum Virium Helsinki and Futurice) in the next two years.
