Dear partners and friends of EIT Digital,

We are back from an unusually busy summer and the autumn will continue in the same pace!

Before the summer, we concluded the selection of our EIT Digital 2021 construction of activities. More than 50 proposals were accepted to launch with us a digital tech startup or product with the Innovation Factory or deliver entrepreneurial digital tech education programmes with the Entrepreneurial Academy.

The Accelerator could welcome 10 additional companies - and the first ever from Hungary! - to its portfolio of now 64 scaleups. And our preacceleration Venture Program selected 33 entrepreneurial teams with deep tech business ideas that will get our support to finalise their MVP and start their venture.

We also enjoy exceptional interest to join our ecosystem and are still busy processing the more than 150 new partner registrations. We are in discussions with the EIT on how this still cumbersome process can be accelerated in the future.

The Master School concluded the intake of our cohort for 2020/2021 and the Summer School successfully moved and ran 14 programs online.

In parallel, we continued to support our ecosystem in managing the consequences of the COVID-19 crisis. As part of the EIT's Crisis Response Initiative, we introduced a Venture Support scheme, launched 9 Innovation Activities dedicated to fighting the effects of the pandemic, and selected teams in four European regions to run pilots for COVID-19 contract tracing using physical tokens.

Tuesday, September 8, we had our General Assembly. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic we were not able to have our physical conference and partner event in Brussels like we are used to, and thus had our General Assembly on-line. Over 100 participants witnessed a smooth execution of the General Assembly and voting. The Assembly took important decisions including (re)appointing our Chairman Linnar Viik and various Supervisory Board members, as well as approving the draft Business Plan 2021. A proposal regarding membership fees did not make it. We look back at a very successful and engaged General Assembly and hope to be able to have our next General Assembly again physically in Brussels as part of our annual conference and partner event.

Despite current restrictions, we prepared numerous activities around our 10th Anniversary. Over the summer, we accelerated the rollout of our Makers & Shapers video journey, continued preparations for our online Anniversary Event on 29 October, and finalised work on our Anniversary Book that will be presented on that occasion.

A full program for this unusual year! With that, I wish you all the best and hope to see you, albeit virtually, at our Anniversary Event later in October!

The **Innovation Activities** effort supports innovators developing solutions leveraging modern digital technology to model, communicate and influence behaviour to manage pandemic lifecycles and to make a significant impact.

Launched by EIT Digital within the "Pay with a Smile" Innovation Activity, the venture is operational in Budapest and started rolling out a pilot in Guadalajara in Spain. Further pilots are planned in Slovenia and the UK. By the end of the year, the solution will be rolled out globally.
